## File your Income Tax for Free!

Need a hand filing your personal income tax return? Can't afford to pay for assistance? If so, the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP) might be a good option for you. Project Glow (WHRC) will be hosting a drop-off location this year at 60 Frances St. This will be on a first come basis Every Tuesday from 9:30am– 11:15am, and Every Wednesday from 1:00pm-2:45pm

Volunteers will not complete income tax returns which require a statement of business or rental income and expenses, which have capital gains, employment expenses, and interest income over \$1,000, income tax returns for deceased or bankrupt individuals, or other complex returns. There are income restrictions to consider:

Single person– income \$35,000 or less

Couples – income \$45,000 or less

One adult with a child – income \$45,000 or less each additional dependent- \$2,500

Canada Revenue has moved to having direct deposit for all Canadians. If you have your tax return done at any of these locations, please bring your banking information, such as a void cheque. ID is needed at all locations.

## Drains and Toilets

Do not let hair go down the bathroom sink or tub drain

Do not put food scraps or cooking grease down your kitchen sink. Put grease in an empty can and put it in the garbage.

Do not put children's toys or feminine hygiene products in the toilet.

These items will cause drains and toilets to become plugged and you will be charged back for the invoice
